WORKSHOP

REDISTRICTING (01): County Clerk Crawley explained that due to the 2010 Census, the Board of Commissioners and Board of Education district lines had to be redrawn. The ideal value of population to have in each district is 10,450. Staff with the help of the Commissioners came up with four scenarios for the Board to choose from.

Mrs. Ruth Lee, Ms. Gussie Nease, and Mr. Mose Mock made comments on the redistricting maps.

After discussion and reviewing different scenarios the Board requested that map version 5 be presented to the State Reapportionment Office on Monday, July 18th at 2:00 p.m.
